Any email requests received after April 15<sup>th</sup> there will be no guarantee of receiving the recommendation letter before the application submission deadline.

A selection board, comprised of members of the Air Cadet B.C. League Committee, will be appointed to consider all eligible candidates. The Chairperson will declare the name of the award recipient and a cheque will be presented to the recipient when all requirements have been satisfied. Following selection, the recipient may be requested to provide a photograph and digital image (in uniform) for the purpose of publicity.

Note: The Parent Sponsoring Committee reserves the right to withhold the award if a candidate fails to attend the post-secondary education institute or provide all the supporting documents. A successful applicant may **only receive one full or shared** Sponsoring Committee Post-Secondary Scholarship Award for the life of one's cadet career with 655 Richmond Squadron.
